Dog Obedience/Agility

For dogs participating in the Dog Obedience and Agility Demo

- Participants must be enrolled in the 4-H Dog Project.
- Dogs must be vaccinated for: Distemper, Hepatitis, Leptospirosis and Parvovirus and Rabies. The dog's vaccination certificate will be checked with the entry form.
- A bitch in season is not permitted to compete.
- A limping or injured dog may be excused at the judge's discretion.
