History: **Milt Thomson** was a Delaware County Fair Director from 1957-1994. He served as Treasurer for many years and helped save the Fair in 1957. **Doug Thomson**, who was Milt’s son, was an active 4-Her, showing Guernsey cows. He continued to be actively involved in the Fair through 1998. The funds for this scholarship were raised by Doug.

Criteria: **Applicants must:**

- Be a current graduate of a public high school in Delaware County, and
- Application, essay and college acceptance letter must be postmarked on or before Friday, July 11th.

A completed application must include:

- The attached application form,
- A 250-500 word essay on:
“Lessons on Life I Learned at the Delaware County Fair”, and
- Copy of a letter of acceptance by the college or post secondary school you plan to attend.
